Fuel suction hose (90/12), fuel return hose (90/11), vent valve (91/8)	take off, fit on. Collect remaining fuel. Seal connections. Check suitability for re-use. detach, hang down and attach. take off, fit on. take off, fit on. remove, install. Replace self-locking nuts. Tightening torque 30 Nm.
Fuel tank (80)	Support fuel tank when performing this step. remove, insert. When removing the fuel tank, ensure that the connection fitting for the vent line (45/2) does not catch on a line. Press exhaust and level line to the left.
